

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

TOWN OF LAWRENCE
Brown County, Wisconsin

OWNER – The Town of Lawrence, acting through its Town Board, hereby gives notice that sealed bids will be received in the Town Hall, 2400 Shady Court, De Pere, Wisconsin 54115 for the following described project.

2019 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – The work shall consist of the following roads:

1. **Yellow Briar Drive (Eisenhower Drive North) (675'x36')**, Pulverize, reconstruct, grade, pave 2.25" binder and 1.75" of surface. Remove and replace 1,200 lineal feet of curb and gutter.
2. **Foxwood Court (490' x22')** Pulverize, grade, Pave 2" base and 1.5" of surface. 2' CAB shoulder
3. **Pepper Ridge Court (375' x22')** Pulverize, grade, Pave 2" base and 1.5" of surface. 2' CAB shoulder
4. **Center Street (485'x 18')** Pulverize, grade, Pave 2" base and 1.5" of surface. 1' CAB shoulder
5. **Wisconsin Street (350'x 18')** Pulverize, grade, Pave 2" base and 1.5" of surface. 1' CAB shoulder
6. **French Road Shoulder (pave 3' shoulder on east side of French from Freedom Road starting at existing 3' shoulder at north end of guard rail going north 1160')** Grade out existing gravel shoulder and pave 3' shoulder then add 2' CAB shoulder
7. **Lawrence Drive Shoulder including radius of Little Rapids (pave 3' shoulder on west side of Lawrence from Little Rapids Road going north) (560' x 3')** Grade out existing gravel shoulder and pave 3' shoulder then add 2' CAB shoulder – Starting at a point of the northeast intersection going north for 560 feet on the west side of Lawrence Drive
8. **Mahogany Circle (Starting and finishing at Mahogany Trail) (approx. 650'x22')**- Remove ramps around manholes and pave final lift 1.5." of surface.
9. **Mid Valley Wedging – approximately 500' x 22' (3310 Mid Valley)**
10. 10 storm inlets reconstruct-replace concrete adjustment rings to proper elevation for inlet,(2 inch thick is the minimum thickness, any adjustment less than 2 inches needs to be solid concrete in- also all adjustment rings need to be back plastered) replace adjoining concrete curb and gutter to nearest joint on both sides of inlet, (match existing curb and gutter elevations, all new curb and gutter shall be rodded into existing curb and gutter, if inlet is in driveway the driveway apron needs to be replaced to match existing) Curb must be back filled with ¾ inch crushed stone in road way and blacktop replaced, back of curb needs to have topsoil and reseeded – a list of addresses will be provided

TIME – Sealed bids will be received until 10:00 a.m. on Friday, April 5, 2019, at the Town of Lawrence Town Hall, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

BIDS – All bids shall be addressed to Patrick Wetzel, Town Administrator, Town of Lawrence, 2400 Shady Court, De Pere, WI 54115. Bids shall be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder and the contract for which the bid is being submitted on the outside of the envelope. All bidders shall bid in accordance with and upon the Bid Forms included in the contract documents.

PROCUREMENT AND EXAMINATION OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS – The contract documents are on file for inspection at the Town of Lawrence Town Hall, 2400 Shady Court, De Pere, WI 54115 or via email at PatrickW@townoflawrence.org.

BID SECURITY – No bid shall be received unless accompanied by a certified check or satisfactory bid bond payable to the Town of Lawrence in an amount not less than 10% of the maximum bid as a guarantee that, if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the contract, performance/payment bonds and insurance certification, as required by the contract documents, within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award.

BID REJECTION – The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the bid or bids which best serves the interests of the Town of Lawrence.

WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS – No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 30-days after the scheduled opening without the consent of the Owner.

COMPLETION OF WORK – All work shall be completed by July 15, 2019. If not completed by said date there shall be a penalty of \$500.00 per day until completed.

GOVERNING LAWS & REGULATIONS – The contract letting shall be subject to the provisions of Sections 60.47, 66.0901, 66.0903, and 779.16 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
